 Make House Numbers Visible from the street Trim trees away form house Clean leaves from roofs and rain gutters Keep property picked up and maintained 	 Never leave cooking unattended Cuff sleeves and turn pot handles inward while cooking When barbequing move away from house Dispose of coals/ashes in metal container
HEATING EQUIPMENT & FIREPLACE	SMOKING MATERIALS & CANDLES
 Keep space heaters at least 3 Feet away from all combustibles Keep newspaper, other combustibles and clutter away from water heater/fireplace/floor heater Install a spark screen in front of fireplace Have chimney inspected and cleaned annually 	 Never leave cigarettes or candles unattended Never smoke in bed Place candles in noncombustible, sturdy holders Keep matches and lighters out of reach of children
Clean lint from behind clothes dryer	SMOKE ALARMS/CO MONITORS
Avoid overloading electrical circuits Do not tack cord to wall or run them under rugs Maintain air space around electrical equipment such as TV, VCR, stereo, etc.	Install smoke alarms inside every bedroom/ every level Test alarms once a month Replace alarm batteries twice a year (Daylight savings) Follow the manufacture guidelines
If you use and extension cord, use only the one that have a built-in circuit breaker	FIRE EXTINGUISHERS
FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS & HAZARDOUS MATERIALS Limit the amount of chemicals stored Store hazardous materials in proper containers with tight-fitting lids and correct identification labels Allow for proper ventilation when using flammable liquids	 Purchase a multi use extinguisher (ABC) Teach your family house to use one/ location P.A.S.S Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep Inspect extinguishers monthly
Store away form any heat source Put oily rags in metal containers with tight-fitting lids, not in a pile where they can spontaneously ignite	DEVELOP & PRACTICE A HOME ESCAPE PLAN Crawl low and under smoke Two exits out of the house A meeting place outside -Dial 9-1-1 in an emergency -Stop, drop, and roll if clothes catch fire
